#### **MULTIPLE INTENTION MASS STARTING 2026**

Beginning in January 2026, every Wednesday Mass at 8:15am will include **Multiple Intentions**. Up to 10 names may be listed per Mass, with each intention offered at \$10. Intentions will be announced during the Wednesday morning liturgy.

#### WHAT ARE MASS INTENTIONS?

When a priest celebrates Mass each day, he offers each Sacrifice of the Mass for a particular person, or intention. By doing so special graces from God are applied upon that person or intention. The act of offering prayers for the dead at Mass goes back to AD 235. Canon Law also confirms this practice and states, "In accord with the approved practice of the Church, any priest celebrating, or concelebrating is permitted to receive an offering to apply the Mass for a specific intention" (Can. 945 §1).

Anyone may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons. For example, Masses can be offered in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

"The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works" (945 §2). This refers to a longstanding practice in the Church of offering a specified amount of money to the Church for a particular intention offered by the priest. This is not the act of selling something sacred for money (simony), but it is for the purpose of supplying items for Mass and for the support of the priest. In the Archdiocese of Toronto, the suggested donation for an announced Mass is \$20, for unannounced \$10.
