

## Twelfth Sunday In Ordinary Time



From the Pastor's Desk: ADIEU TO ST. JOHN'S: As King David sings in Psalm 108: "My heart is ready, O God; my heart is ready. I will sing, I will sing your praise. Awake, my soul; awake, lyre and harp. I will awake the dawn." It has been my privilege to sing the Lord's praises with you at St. John's Parish these last four years. I am grateful that I got to know you all twice: once with masks, and then again without. (And I much prefer the latter.) It is the unique privilege of a priest to walk alongside God's people through a great variety of life's journeys. The greatest regret of leaving a parish is knowing that I won't be continuing to walk with you on those journeys still in progress, but I am very thankful that a fine priest is coming to St. John's to continue the work of accompaniment. I am confidently handing on the keys to Fr. Joshua Roldan as I begin new journeys as the pastor of Precious Blood Parish. I thank all of you for your support and encouragement, and most especially for your prayers. I have always believed that my work would not be possible without the prayers of you, the parishioners. All the words of encouragement, even brief ones, have meant a great deal. I have seen the Lord doing great things among us, and I pray that He will continue to bless you and all your loved ones with "every spiritual blessings in the heavenly places." (Eph. 1:3)

GOSPEL REFLECTION: In Mark 4:35-41 we come to a familiar story that pushes us to ask an important question: Who do we believe God to be? And along with that a related question: how does our understanding of who God is impact the way we respond to difficult seasons in life? These are important questions and questions that at times have divergent answers. While we profess a high view of God and of His power and goodness, we may be tempted to view our situations and respond with worry and fear. We may determine that God is negligent or uncaring. The story of Jesus calming the storm is a story about the revelation of Jesus as God. In addition we have the reminder that He can be trusted. Like the disciples we must consider whether we will respond to the situations of our lives with faith in God or with fear of our situations...LPi

- -Read a portion of one of the Gospels every day. It might perhaps be the Gospel reading for the Mass of the day, or it might simply be a chapter a day. Each chapter takes only a few minutes to read prayerfully, so as to encounter Jesus, and to experience the love of his Sacred Heart.
- -It is spiritually valuable to participate in Mass at any time, but to do so on consecutive First Fridays is a custom associated with devotion to the Sacred Heart.
- -Place an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, and consecrate your family to the Sacred Heart. As it has been said, the family that prays together stays together, and both devotion to the love of the Sacred Heart and the praying of the Rosary can strengthen the love at the heart of each family. ARCHBISHOP LEO WRITES TO MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT:
Regarding Bill S-210: On Wednesday, June 12, 2024, the Most Reverend Francis Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto wrote to Members of Parliament in ridings within the Archdiocese of Toronto regarding the

proposed Bill S-210 which seeks to protect youth from access to explicit online material.

In his letter encouraging MP's to support the bill, Archbishop Leo writes, "This piece of legislation would be a step forward as we look to build a society which is free from such detrimental and unethical practices, protected against a toxic industry which normalizes the degradation of human persons, desensitizes the spirit and celebrates violence and immorality." "We look to a future imbued with a robust moral fabric which allows for individuals, families and communities to thrive, to grow and to lead lives of fulfillment and where our children are kept safe from such addictive and nocent influences." Full text of the archbishop's letter can be found here. According to the Parliament of Canada website, the purpose of Bill S-210 is, "to protect public health and public safety and, in particular, to: protect the mental health of young persons by restricting their access to sexually explicit material; protect Canadians — in particular, young persons and women the harmful effects of the exposure of young persons to sexually explicit material, including demeaning material and material depicting sexual violence; and deter organizations that make sexually explicit material available on the Internet for commercial purposes from allowing young persons to access that material."
