

PRAY THE ROSARY

Twenty-Fourth Sunday In Ordinary Time



Reflection: Who do you say that I am? That question marks a turning point in the gospels. The disciples, like the people, have been thinking of Jesus as one of the prophets of old. Ezra was considered the last of the prophets so it had been over 400 years since they had had a prophet. Now John the Baptist had come and people through Jesus might be bringing back the time of the prophets. Jesus is bringing something else. You are the Christ. Peter's answer is the correct one, but Peter and the others still need to truly learn what it means. The main mission of Jesus' time on earth will become clearer and Jesus will turn more and more to Jerusalem and the cross. Jesus immediately makes the first prediction of the Passion. His Passion, death and Resurrection will be how Jesus accomplishes the mission of bringing eternal salvation to the universe. This is not what Peter or the other disciples were hoping to hear. The message becomes harder to hear when Jesus adds that to participate in what is coming they too need to carry their crosses and follow Him. As James says in his letter, faith without words is dead. Peter believes in Jesus, but is reluctant to believe everything Jesus teaches. Once the disciples believe all that Jesus taught after Easter, they still have to struggle to live it out. We need to have faith in Jesus as the Christ. We cannot truly have faith without knowledge, so we cannot remain ignorant of the deeper meaning of Jesus' mission and say we follow Jesus. We cannot say we have faith and knowledge if we do not act on them. People have sought to remove the cross from the call. We can't have Easter without Good Friday. We can hear how great they are and how they deserve to be comfortable even now. The life of following Christ is always a choice. A choice to pick up the cross or not. It is a choice to follow Christ or not. Jesus is quite clear as to what is needed. If you wish to follow Jesus take up your cross and follow......Fr. Giovanoni
