

NEXT WEEKEND - WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGES: "Free to Choose Whether to Migrate or to Stay" In his message, Pope Francis acknowledges that while the decision to migrate should always be free, in many cases it is not. This point is emphasized by St. John Paul II: "building conditions of peace means in practice being seriously committed to safeguarding first of all the right not to emigrate, that is, the right to live in peace and dignity in one's own country." As he concluded his message, Pope Francis referenced the words of the Lord when He said "... I was a stranger, and you welcomed me" reminding us that the Lord's words are a "constant admonition to see in the migrant not simply a brother or sister in difficulty, but Christ himself, who knocks at our door."

first come, first served.


THE SEASON OF CREATION: running

and Peace Flow." In the words of Pope Francis, this




