

PRAY THE ROSARY

Fourth Sunday Of Advent



Today is the Fourth Sunday of Advent and we light the last Purple Candle, the Candle of Joy. We hear from Mary, who while probably scared, confused and awe-struck, responds to the angel's news out of love. She answers God, "let it be with me," a short, powerful affirmation of her partnership in this extraordinary act of love becoming flesh to shine into our darkness. May we follow in Mary's footsteps as she bravely makes her way to the stable. And may we follow with hearts and mind set on the love of God, open to the impossible becoming possible.

Note from the Pastor's Desk: Emmanuel - "God with us" is how the Holy Scriptures, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, told us to expect the Messiah. The people of Israel learned to long for a Messiah, a Saviour, who would be "God with us". But hidden in the prophecy were clues that would only become clear when this Messiah would die and rise from the dead, and be known forever as Jesus Christ, the Son of God incarnate. The humility of this Messiah could not be imagined by the high and mighty, but would become known to the lowly, beginning with poor shepherds in their fields, far from the elite in their comfortable homes. God has always reserved a special place in his heart for the poor, the powerless, the forgotten ones of society. Prophecies foretold that Israel would be humbled, and so prepare for this lesson, as Zephaniah writes: "For I will leave in the midst of you a people humble and lowly. They shall seek refuge in the name of the Lord — the remnant of Israel; they shall do no wrong and utter no lies, nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouths. Then they will pasture and lie down, and no one shall make them afraid." It is in the pastures of our hearts that we will meet the Lord, when we leave behind our daily divisions, admit that we need a Saviour and Messiah, and want to be as innocent as sheep that run toward the call of their true Master. Rather than trying to be earthly rulers of our lives, let us seek Jesus in every relationship we forge as his people, put aside our differences, forgive one another, and then we will know the humility that makes room for the humble Christ child to appear.
