Love one another. Just as I have loved you.... John 13-34-35

“There’s something different about you.” Think about the times in your life when this has been said to you. Maybe it was after someone complimented you on a job well done. 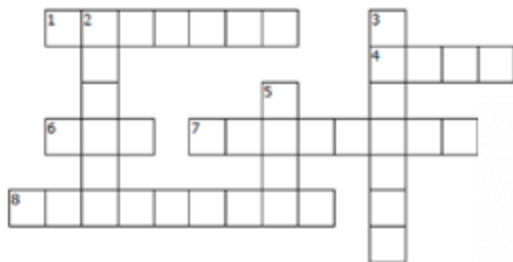
