



Twenty-Eighth Sunday In Ordinary Time



Come to the Feast.

From the Pastor's Desk: THE DOOR OF THE

KINGDOM: When you next come to church, think about what you are doing as you climb the stairs or ascend the ramp. You are like the pilgrims going to Jerusalem, the ascent to Mount Zion, to the temple of the living God. The door of the church is not an ordinary door. It is the threshold of the Kingdom of God, as we will do our best to realize in our worship in this place. You leave the profane world, and enter a sacramental world, filled with signs of the divine. No harsh word is to be spoken in this place; the words of the liturgy, which we speak together, are only of charity and goodness. Signs of the angels and saints are seen in the windows above and around us, and beautiful hymns echo with those of heaven. Words of contrition, repentance and forgiveness are said together, and we listen to the inspired word of God, and let these words settle in our hearts. There are no special places for the rich or poor; all are equal brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ. The door of the church is the place where all these things begin. Appropriately, we sprinkle ourselves with holy water on entering the church, making the Sign of the Cross, a reminder that we first came into the living Church by the pouring of water, in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Make an effort to pause on your way into the Church next time, and consider this way of encountering our God at the door to the Kingdom.

The Mysteries of the Rosary

Have you ever wanted to explore the life of Jesus and Mary in a deeper way? Lets explore the Joyful & Luminous mysteries this week.

Each decade highlights a sacred episode:

Joyful Mysteries: Through the Annunciation (1) and Visitation (2), we get a glimpse at Mary's joyful yes to God. She gives birth to Jesus in the Nativity (3). Mary and Joseph present their son at the temple (4) and bring him there again when he is a teenager (5).

<u>Luminous Mysteries</u>: Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River (1) before Mary gives him a nudge to his first miracle at Cana (2). Jesus proclaims the Gospel (3), is transfigured on Mount Tabor (4), and institutes the Eucharist (5). The light is shining!


