**PRAY THE ROSARY**

*Most Holy Trinity Sunday*



**Reflection:** In Baptism, God who is Love takes us in; the Father, the Son, and the Spirit receive us, and we receive them, the Trinity. The mystery of Baptism follows what Jesus commanded, and it says, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The same gift of Baptismal immersion into the Trinity reaches out for us in the mystery of the Eucharist. To believe in, eat, and drink the Eucharist is to let the Father send the Son to rise in Body and Blood, out of death into glory, to breathe the Spirit into our bodies and souls. To be honestly one with the Trinity in the Eucharist, let us at least begin the work of handing ourselves over for the full mystery of the Father, the Son, and the Spirit to declare itself to us, within us, and through us. In this way, the Trinity will go on working with us to uphold and spread the Gospel through the lives we choose to live. By the loving will of the Father, the Spirit breathes anew within us when we eat and drink the Body and Blood of the Son, and so each of us can live, show, and say what Jesus says: "Everything that the Father has is mine." .....Lpi
