CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE Fr. Paul Magyar



Dear Brother Knights:

A question that people have
regarding the catholic faith is: who
will go to heaven ? Jesus in the
gospel of Luke 4:15-21 reads a
passage from the prophet Isaiah in
the synagogue at Nazareth. Jesus
uses the passage to demonstrate
and explain to the people that this is what he came to do:
Bring good news to the poor, release to the captives and
recovery of sight to the blind.

The good news is that the resurrection of Jesus allows for
everyone to enter into heaven first. One must repent their
sins, believe in Christ and follow him. However, how is this
possible for a person who rejects Christ and God? As Jesus
says, He will open the eyes of the blind. This means that
Jesus will open the eyes of the blind rejectors and give them
the opportunity to understand.

Any person who is brought to a hospital has the opportunity
to be healed whether they are a criminal or not. Criminals
are not sent to be euthanized at a hospital upon reception.
God's love is unconditional, rejecting people into heaven
would be placing a condition and therefore its not
unconditional love. The prodigal son returns to his father
who welcomes him with love; the good Samaritan heals the
stranger who was beaten up by robbers. These are parables
of God's unconditional love. That is good news !

Everyone who enters into heaven will meet Christ face to
face for their particular judgement. Everyone will have the
opportunity to see Christ. If a person rejects the
opportunities that Christ gives them while in heaven, and
then rejects to serve Christ himself in heaven; then such a

A CALL TO PRAYER FOR UKRAINE:

Never mind that January 26 has passed us by, the Ukraine situation has become a serious concern. Our pope has asked us to join him in prayers, as do our Supreme Knight Pat Kelly per his letter on January 23:

“Yesterday, Pope Francis called for a day of prayer for peace in Ukraine to be held this coming Wednesday, Jan. 26. Clearly, the cause is one that has worldwide implications, but in a particular way we wish to stand with our brother Knights in Ukraine, where the Order has had a presence for nearly a decade.

“To express our solidarity with the Ukrainian people, I urge brother Knights around the world to join with Pope Francis and the Universal Church in praying for peace in Ukraine on Wednesday.

“Specifically, I encourage you to join me at 3 p.m. Eastern U.S. time, if possible, in praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and the Prayer of St. Francis. Already I have heard from brother Knights in Poland, who have pledged to stand with their Ukrainian neighbors and brothers in prayerful solidarity at that hour.

“Thank you for answering our Holy Father’s call to prayer. Whether you are able to join together in groups, or you pray alone or with your family, we stand in solidarity and in fraternity with our brothers in Ukraine.”

Trillium and State Council Awards 2021 – 2022

Brother Knights,

Due to the COVID 19 global pandemic changes have been made to the following. TRILLIUM AWARD Because Ontario State cancelled the Basketball Free Throw, Soccer Challenge, and Hockey Challenge for the 2020-2021 Fraternal Year, the following elective requirements have been adjusted. New Elective Requirements

Bronze; 5 mandatory + 5 elective requirements

Silver; 5 mandatory + 7 elective requirements

Gold; 5 mandatory + 8 elective requirements

The mandatory requirements for the Trillium Award remain unchanged. Ontario State Council Awards State Deputy Longevity Community Service Award – SO-40

The Longevity Award requires a council program to run for 10 consecutive years or more. Councils that were unable to run a program due to the pandemic will not be penalized.

The 2021-2022 Fraternal Year will be considered a ‘by-year’ for all long running council programs; the clock won’t be reset to zero due to circumstances beyond the council’s control. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

LIFE: MARCH FOR LIFE IN WASHINGTON DC – Jan. 21, 2022 (AP) — From <https://www.kofc.org/en/news-room/articles/knights-march-for-life.html>:

“The annual anti-abortion rally in the nation’s capital sounded more like a victory celebration as speakers expressed a growing sense of optimism that their long-sought goal, a sweeping rollback of abortion rights in America, was finally in reach.

“Thousands of protesters rallied in the bitter cold Friday and marched to the Supreme Court, which has indicated it will allow states to impose tighter restrictions on abortion with a ruling in the coming months — and possibly overturn the landmark 1973 Roe v. Wade decision that affirmed the constitutional right to an abortion.

“Supreme Knight Kelly expressed support for the march as Knights from across the U.S. assembled in nation’s capital during historic year for protection of the unborn.

“Knights of Columbus from across the United States joined other pro-life advocates Jan. 21 in Washington, D.C., to speak for the rights of unborn children at the March for Life. Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly, attending the demonstration for the first time as leader of the Knights, expressed his support for the tens of thousands of people who took part in the annual rally and march from the National Mall to the Supreme Court building.”

COMMUNITY: COATS FOR KIDS PROGRAM

The Ontario Coats for Kids Program continues to be a significant initiative by the Knights of Columbus Organization. As an organization, we have so far distributed 6,468 coats in 2021.

FAMILY: FAMILY PRAYER NIGHT

Catholics often struggle with the reality that they do not have the opportunity to socialize and/or pray with other faith-filled Catholic families. It can be quite a challenge to raise our children in the faith when their only exposure comes from Mom and Dad. Put plainly, the majority of our time can easily be spent in secular circles unless we intentionally create ways to live out the domestic church.

Looking for a reason to gather the family for a spiritual reunion? Why not have a family prayer night at least once a month.

Family Prayer Night is an opportunity for children to be exposed to regular people living their faith in a casual setting. Families of council members, as well as other Catholic families within the parish and community, will gather for prayer, dinner and fellowship. Multiple groups can be formed and families are encouraged to rotate between these groups.

Alternatively, families can designate a particular prayer evening during the month, complete with dinner and bonding, making prayer a part of their overall family life.

FAITH: CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

Every few years, the Knights of Columbus selects an icon of a saint whose patronage is particularly inspiring to Knights and their communities. Each jurisdiction receives one or several of these icons which travel from council to council and serve as the centerpieces for prayer services in parishes throughout the Order. Since this year was declared the year of St. Joseph, the icon of the Saint is passed on for veneration this year 2021. Check with your DD on how your council can participate. Here is the prayer of consecration to St. Joseph:

Act of Consecration to St. Joseph

O dearest St. Joseph, I consecrate myself to your honor and give myself to you, that you may always be my father, my protector and my guide in the way of salvation. After your example may I do all my actions for the greater glory of God, in union with the Divine Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. O Blessed St. Joseph, pray for me, that I may share in the peace and joy of your holy death. Amen.
